1. **PURPOSE.** This Directive, in accordance with the authority in References (a) through (d), implements policy to provide a uniform system of healthcare managerial accounting for the Military Health System. MEPRS provides detailed uniform performance indicators, common expense classification by work center/cost center, uniform reporting of personnel utilization data by work centers, and a labor cost assignment methodology established in Reference (e).

2. **APPLICABILITY.** This Directive applies to Joint Task Force National Capital Region Medical (JTF CapMed) and all Joint Military Treatment Facilities and Centers in the National Capital Region (i.e., Fort Belvoir Community Hospital, Walter Reed National Military Medical Center, National Intrepid Center of Excellence, and the Joint Pathology Center).

3. **DEFINITIONS.** Terms used in this Directive are defined in Reference (e).

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4. POLICY. It is JTF CapMed policy to follow the procedures established in Reference (e).

5. RELEASABILITY. UNLIMITED. This Directive is approved for public release and is available on the Internet from the JTF CapMed Web Site at: www.capmed.mil.

6. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Directive is effective immediately.
